## **Social Opportunities**

### **Alumni Association**

The group maintains an alumni database to notify alumni of upcoming parish events and activities.

### **Athletic Association**

The Athletic Association is an organization of parish men and women dedicated to providing athletic instruction, opportunity and experience for the young people of St. Stephen Protomartyr Parish. The athletic programs serve as a vehicle for the physical, mental and Christian development of our parish's young men and women. Completion of the Safe Environment Program is required for all volunteers over 18 years old.

### **Donut Sunday**

On the first Sunday of each month coffee, juice, bagels and donuts are provided after each Mass. This is a time for fellowship and an opportunity to meet new parishioners. Volunteers act as hosts and help with set up and clean up.

### **Men's Club (Holy Name Society)**

The Holy Name Society provides the men of the parish an opportunity for social interaction, outreach to others, personal enrichment and participation in the various activities of the parish. Meetings are on the second Tuesday of every month at 8:00 PM, September through May, with a prayer service in the church at 7:30 PM. Men 18 years of age and who have graduated from High School are welcome and encouraged to join.

### **Women's Club (Women for All Seasons)**

Women's Club: Women of All Seasons is for women 18 years of age and who have graduated from High School. It is dedicated to providing women of the parish an opportunity to enjoy each other's company while working together in support of the church. Its activities include raising funds for the St. Stephen's community and church. We meet only 4 times a year and we will have events throughout the school year.

### **50+**

A social organization for anyone over 50, the 50+ Club gathers on the third Thursday of every month at 11:00 AM. They meet in the parish hall for prayer followed by a business meeting, lunch, socializing, and bingo. The meetings last until 2:30 PM. The 50+ Club sponsors various events, outings, guest speakers and musical groups.

### **Scouting**

- **Boy Scouts:** Boys in grades five and above. Boys do not need to be a member of the parish to participate. Meetings are Wednesday evenings from 7:00 PM - 8:30 PM  
Cub Scouts: Tigers: first grade, Wolfs: second grade, Bears: third grade, Webelos: fourth

and fifth grade. Pack meetings are every third Thursday at 7:00 PM in the parish hall. Leaders meet every second Tuesday at 7:00 PM.

- **Girl Scouts:** For girls in kindergarten through high school. The girls do not need to be parishioners to participate.

***Completion of the Safe Environment Program is required for all volunteers over 18 years old.***
